NORTH MISSOURI SHOW CIRCUIT GENERAL RULES

All saddle clubs or organizations wishing to host a NMSC show may retain all proceeds for the gate fee, cook shack, etc.

The Hosting club is responsible for hiring and paying the Judge, Ringmaster, Announcer, etc. The Hosting Club is responsible for having the show grounds prepared and lining up personnel to run the show. The Hosting Club will provide the P.A. system and Timing equipment for the Races. (Stopwatches or Electric timer) and also Poles, Barrels, Flags and a Low Jump (combination race) for the races. The hosting club shall charge any class fee they wish and payback in any manner they decide upon. The hosting club shall be responsible for ribbons, Trophies, and obtaining sponsors for their show classes.

The NMSC Show Committee requires that all of its point classes be held at each show. Any additional non point classes may be added by the hosting club, Jackpot etc.....All Jackpot classes shall pay 100% of entry fees unless stated otherwise on the show bill. The hosting club shall pay the NMSC the fee of \$1.00 (one dollar) per entry in all NMSC Point classes. This is the only fee to be charged to the hosting club by the NMSC Show Committee. This money is to be used to fund the Year End Awards.

The hosting club is responsible for printing and distribution of all showbills and advertisement. All Fees such as Entry, Gate fee and paybacks shall be printed on the Showbill. The showbill shall have the names and phone numbers of the NMSC Point Recorder which for 2006 is Jean Beauvais 816-580-3761 and also contacts for the Hosting club for show information and in case of inclement weather. the Hosting club shall let the NMSC know 24 hours in advance if canceling a show, so that in may be posted on the web site. www.nmsc.2ya.com.

The NMSC show committee will furnish Entry Sheets for all Classes. These must be used for all classes.

Membership for the North Missouri Show Circuit (NMSC) is \$15.00 for family or individual per year. Membership forms shall be available at all shows or by contacting Jean Beauvais 34302 W. 220th St. Lawson, Mo. 64062 or phone 816-580-3761. Anyone wishing to nominate a horse or other animal for Year end Awards shall file a form with the NMSC Point Recorder Jean Beauvais and pay a fee of \$5.00 per horse or animal per year. All NMSC show point classes shall be counted, starting on the date of nomination. Points will not be retroactive.

YOU DO NOT NEED TO BE A MEMBER TO SHOW! Only if you are nominating for year end points.

To qualify for year-end awards animals must show twice (2 times) in each point class. Year end Awards shall be awarded at an Annual Awards Dinner. Time, Date and location to be determined. The top 5 nominated animals will be placed for NMSC year end point classes by the following point system:

1st Place-5 points 2nd Place-4 points 3rd Place-3 points 4th Place-2 points 5th Place-1 point

The rule book shall be available at all NMSC point shows.....

The Judges Decision is final. A judge may judge only one NMSC Show per year. A judge may not nominate a horse or animal or show for points in the same calendar year as he or she judges a NMSC show. Judge shall not count points of on Halter horses with saddle marks.

No Stallions to be shown or Handled by anyone under 18 years of age.

NO CRUELTY OR MISTREATMENT OF ANY ANIMAL WILL BE TOLERATED. ANYONE ABUSING ANY ANIMAL WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE GROUNDS. All abuses will be brought to the attention of the NMSC show committee members that are available at the show.

Age shall be determined by the person or animals age as of January 1st of current year. Please do not hesitate to ask Questions of the NMSC committee. We are wanting to put the FUN back in showing.....We wish all a Happy and Safe show season.

Saturday and/or Sunday shows will not start before 11:00 A.M. Unless show committee deems otherwise.

CLASS RULES

To qualify for year end awards animals must show twice (2 times) in each point class.

Shows must have a break after the Leadline class and another break before the running classes.

Yearling Lungeline: pattern for Conformation Inspection and Trot-Off for soundness. 1. Horse is walked to first cone and pause for conformation. 2. After inspection, horse is trotted around second cone for soundness. e orses showing evidence of lameness should be excused from the class at that time (See rule book for pattern).

Beginning Riders: May not enter any other riding class except other walk trot classes

Green As Grass Horses: Horses that show in this class are ineligible for any other class except other walk trot classes.

Any Rider that breaks beginning rider or green as grass horse rules shall lose all points in all point classes for the entire year.

AQHA Reining patterns will be used

Free Style Reining: pattern to be 2 to 4 minutes. Must provide your own music CD. Costumes are optional, emphasis shall be on performing reining maneuvers to music. Riders are allowed to use two (2) hands. Minimum maneuvers required are: three (3) stops, four (4) left spins, four (4) right spins (not necessarily consecutive) one lead change at a canter to the left and one lead change to the right. Judging will be on technical merit. Other than as prescribed, no gait is specified. Failure to perform all the required maneuvers will result in no score. riders are encouraged to use music and costumes which permit them to show the athletic ability of the horse.

NO HORSE shall show more than once in each class

RACE RULES

Knocking over any Pole, Barrel, Jump etc. shall result in a five second penalty for each occurrence.

Riders may touch poles or barrels.

Failure to put flag in barrel in Flag Race shall be a no time.

Combination Race: (See rule book for pattern). Riders must start on the RIGHT side of the 1st pole. Failure to jump or put flag in barrel will constitute a 5 second penalty per occurrence.

Cantering more than two (2) strides in the walk trot classes will be a No Time.

No horse shall show more than once in each class.
